Palm Craft

- **NOTE:** A fun option is to make custom pieces of green paper by mixing different shades of green tempera paint or water paint and painting them onto white tissue paper. Finger painting, paint brushes, toothbrush flicking, string painting, potato stamp painting and sponges can all be used to create different patterns and looks on your paper.

Materials:

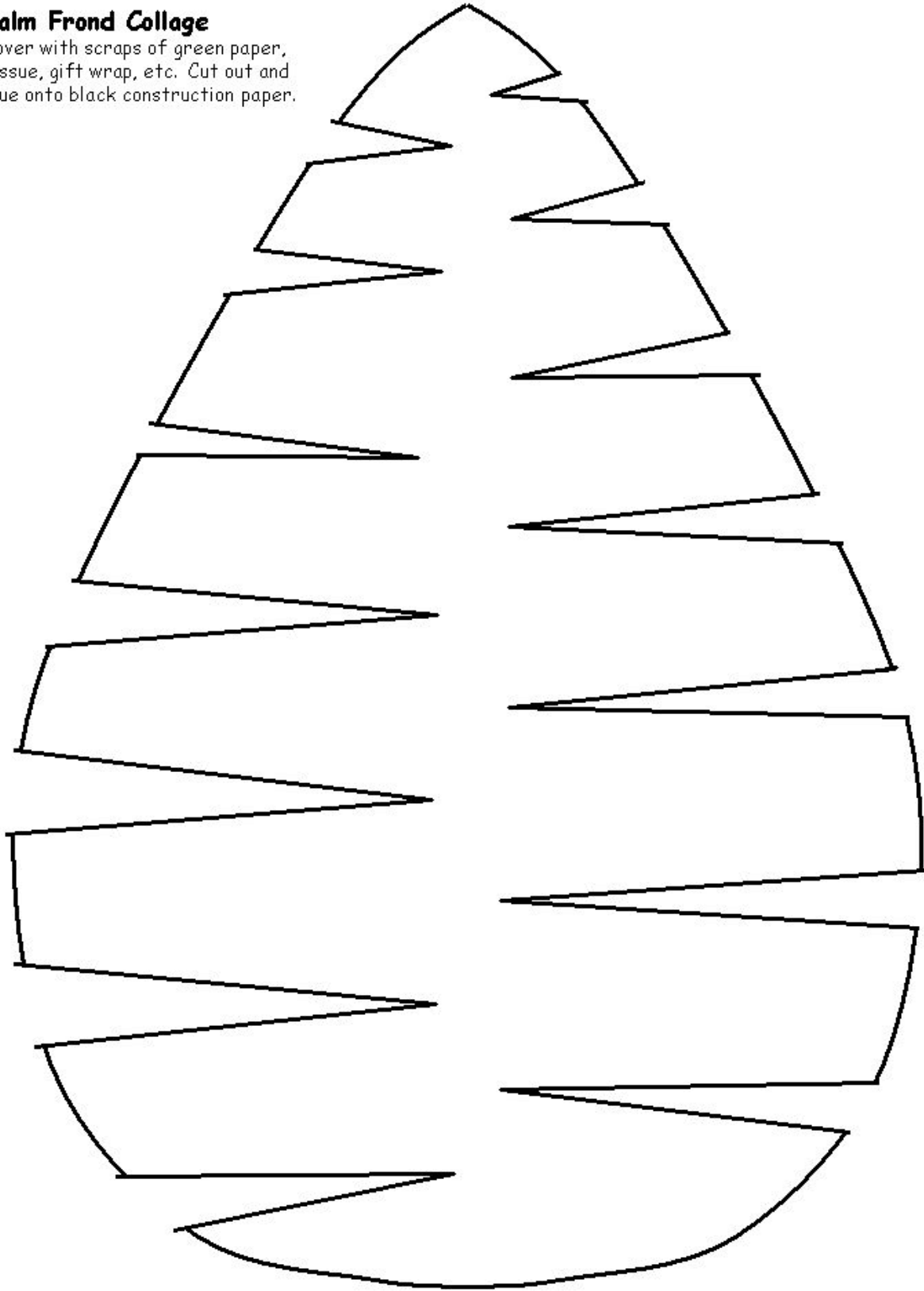
- printer
- paper
- scraps of green construction paper, tissue paper, gift wrap, felt, etc. in different shades and patterns
- glue (can thin with a bit of water for easier application)
- Any color construction paper
- scissors.
- **OPTIONAL:** glitter glue and something to color with.

Instructions:

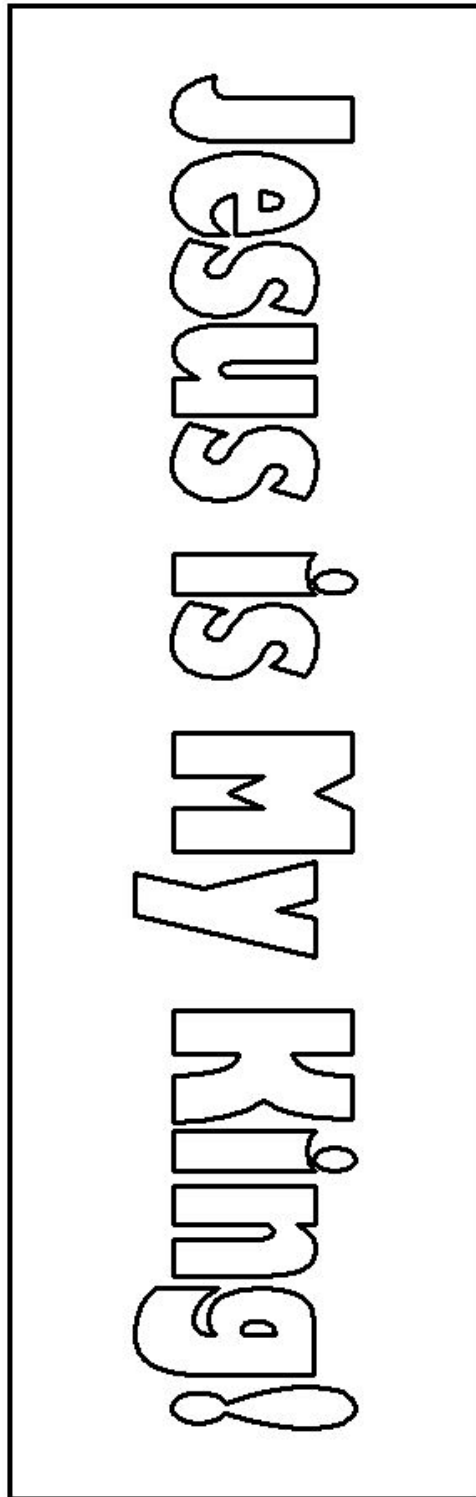
- Print out the palm template and the message template
- Spread a thin layer of glue all over the leaf template. It's very important to get full coverage so you may want to use a paint brush or Q-tip to spread the glue.
- Put scraps of green paper all over to completely cover the leaf.
- Let dry
- While the leaf is drying, cut out and color the optional message template or use glitter glue to fill in the letters if you prefer.
- Cut out the leaf (you should be able to still see enough of the lines of the leaf to do the cutting)
- Glue the leaf to a background piece of construction paper
- Glue or tape the message template to the bottom of the construction paper.

Palm Leaf Fold and Cut Craft

This is a fun Palm Sunday craft that works a lot like cutting out paper snowflakes. The fronds end up being large enough that the children can carry them around waving them for a Palm Sunday parade.

Materials:

- printer
- paper
- scissors
- paper clips
- green construction paper
- scotch tape
- OPTIONAL: Green pipe cleaner or stick

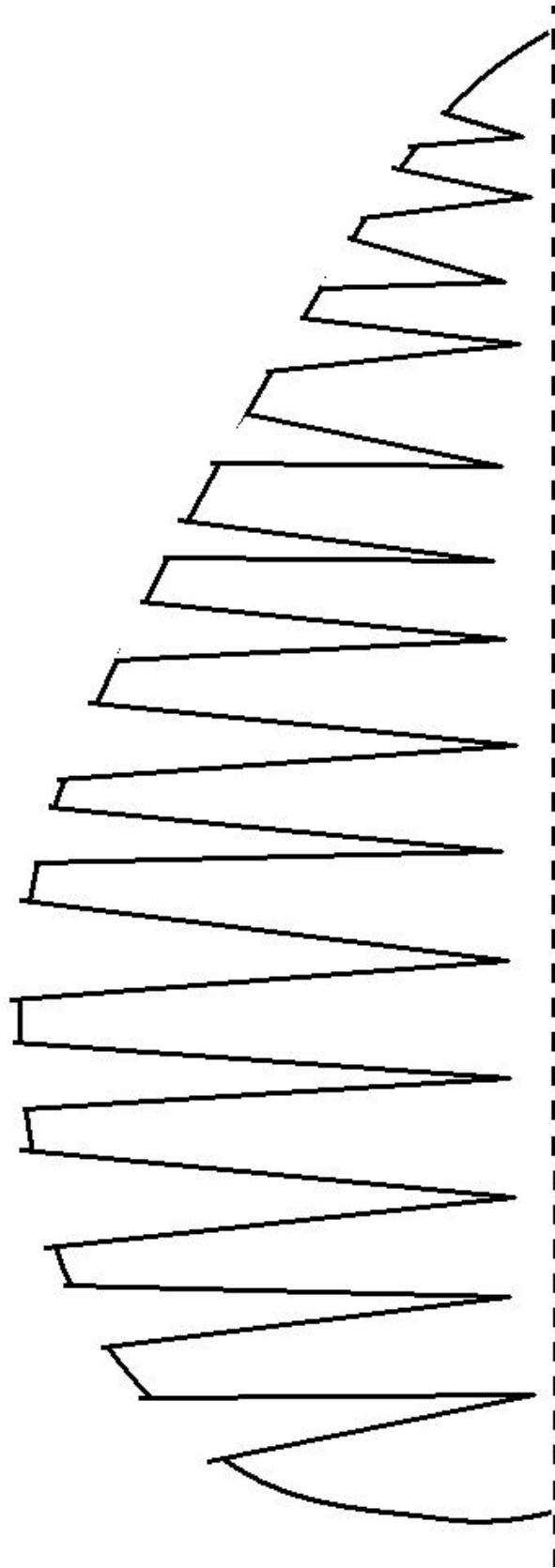
Instructions:

- Print out the template.
- Cut this template along the dotted line.



- Fold a piece of green construction paper in half and paper clip the template so the dotted line is along the fold.
- Cut through the template and both layers of construction paper along the black lines.
- Discard the template (unless you want to make more leaves).
- Unfold the construction paper to see your finished palm leaf.
- Roll a second piece of green construction paper into as tight a tube as possible and tape it so it will stay. Tape that to the center as a stem. You can also use a pipe cleaner or stick from outdoors.





Paper Palm Leaf

Cut this template along the dotted line.

Fold a piece of green construction paper in half and paper clip the template so the dotted line is along the fold.

Cut through the template and both layers of construction paper along the black lines.

Discard the template (unless you want to make more leaves).

Unfold the construction paper to see your finished palm leaf.

Optional: Tape a green pipe cleaner or thin rolled tube of construction paper to the center as a stem.
