





Color a bright or colorful “burst” on any colored paper (you could even cut out tinfoil). Then print and cut out the Jesus silhouette below and glue to your burst of light.

Instructions:

1. Read Mark 9:2-9 to the children and discuss. We spent a while talking about what the word “transfiguration” means (A complete change of form or appearance into a more beautiful or spiritual state.)
After six days Jesus took Peter, James and John with him and led them up a high mountain, where they were all alone. There he was transfigured before them. His clothes became dazzling white, whiter than anyone in the world could bleach them. And there appeared before them Elijah and Moses, who were talking with Jesus
2. Continue reading through verse 9 taking time to emphasis verse 5
While he was still speaking, a bright cloud covered them, and a voice from the cloud said, “This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased. Listen to him!”
3. Now pass out the cups and spoons. Fill each child’s cup with 3 scoops of ice-cream. As you do this emphasise the 3 men who appeared on the mountain: Jesus, Moses and Elijah.
4. Now for the “cloud”! Pour cola over the ice-cream and watch the froth rise.
5. By the time we had repeated the process for each child all the children knew the story well.

2 After six days Jesus took Peter, James and John with him and led them up a high mountain, where they were all alone. 5 Peter said to Jesus, “Rabbi, it is good for us to be here. Let us put up three shelters—one for you, one for Moses and one for Elijah.” **6** (He did not know what to say, they were so frightened.)

7 Then a cloud appeared and covered them, and a voice came from the cloud: “This is my Son, whom I love. Listen to him!”

8 Suddenly, when they looked around, they no longer saw anyone with them except Jesus.

9 As they were coming down the mountain, Jesus gave them orders not to tell anyone what they had seen until the Son of Man had risen from the dead.
